## General Rules

- 1 The competition will be run strictly under British Riding Club Rules 2024.
- 2 In the event of cancellation of this event £5 shall be retained per competitor.
- 3 All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and conditions within this schedule.
- 4 The Judge's decision is final.
- 5 ALL HORSES/PONIES should travel with their passport.
- 6 Health and Safety – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards,
- 7 Disclaimer of Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way what so ever.
- 8 Protective Headgear – Protective Headgear must be worn at all times by anyone riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. See BRC RULE BOOK for current standards.  
All hats must be tagged with a **PINK Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC.**
- 9 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times while on the show ground.
- 10 Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees
- 11 Only riders and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities at FSC.
- 12 **Please do not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park.**
- 13 Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers & left unattended.
- 14 All ridden horses/ponies must be 4yrs or over.
- 15 Protests – These must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be addressed to the organiser of the competition.
- 16 All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.
- 17 Covid-19 – Most importantly, anyone displaying Covid-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. If in doubt please complete a flow test before arriving.  
Please keep numbers to a minimum and observe social distancing measures at all times.
